In our pilot episode, Simon talked about what we as the World Business Dialogue want to achieve with this podcast series.

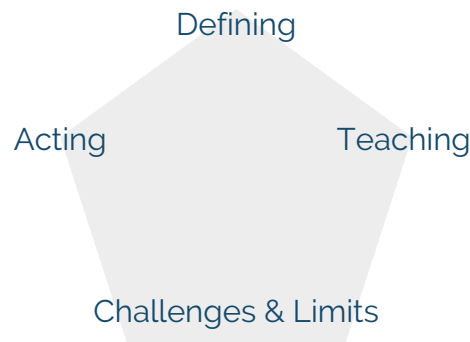
Why do we discuss Responsible Leadership? What topics do we discuss in that area? How can you get involved?
